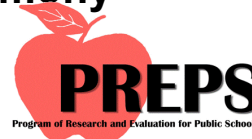

Incomplete forms cannot be processed. Fees may be remitted pre-conference by mail or during on-site registration at the conference.

**Checks should be made payable to MAPE. No telephone or fax registration please.** To qualify for member rates, a registrant's school district must maintain an active membership in the MAPE or PREPS organization. Costs for CEU credits will be \$20.00 and will be collected on-site separately from conference registration. SEMI credit is available upon request.

### **Cancellations and Substitutions**

All cancellations must be in writing and sent to *MAPE*. Registrants whose cancellations are received on or before March 13, 2012, will be charged a \$50.00 cancellation fee.
